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Course Objectives:

In this class, students will...

- Identify lines, shapes, colors, textures, forms, patterns in artworks
- Expand their abilities to use elements of art and principles of design to create artworks
- Use art media and techniques to create artworks at beginner level, including drawing, collage, and paper crafts
- Complete art projects independently and collaboratively
- Examine artworks in different cultures and create art inspired by these cultures and artists

Jun.7 Practice drawing: Number animals

Students will learn how to draw lines, dots, and shapes to turn numbers into animals.

Jun.14 Practice drawing: decorative Patterns

Students will learn how to use lines, dots, and shapes to create patterns.

Jun.21 Art work: a Pattern Snail

Students will implement drawing, paper cutting and patterns in an artwork.

Jun.28 Practice drawing: sea animals

Students will learn how to draw different sea animals.

July.5 Artwork: exploration of a dark sea

Students will complete the art work with a zipper bag, a black paper and a white cardboard.

July.12 Artwork: tree landscapes

Students will learn how to draw tree branches and leaves on color papers

July.19 Still life drawing: a cup of hot coco

Students will learn how to sketch a cup of hot coco.

July.26 Still life drawing: a cup of hot coco

Students will complete the artwork with colors and patterns.

Aug.2 Animal portrait: An animal in sweater

Students will learn how to sketch a bear in sweater.

Aug.9 Animal portrait: An animal in sweater

Students will complete the artwork with colors and patterns.

Aug.16 Picasso portrait

Students will learn how to draw body parts in Picasso style.

Students will implement drawing, paper collage and patterns to create a portrait of a family member.
