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Course Objectives:

In this class, students will...

- Enhance lines, shapes, colors, textures, forms, patterns in artworks
- Expand their abilities to use elements of art and principles of design to create artworks
- Use art media and techniques to create artworks including drawing, painting, collage, and 3D crafts
- Complete art projects independently and collaboratively
- Examine artworks in different cultures and create art inspired by these cultures and artists

Student Requirement:

- 7+ years old
- Interest in creating art
- Basic drawing and painting skills

Art Supplies and materials:

Students should have pencils, 24+ color pencils, an eraser, a 9x12 drawing pad (or bigger), four 9x12 canvas panels or watercolor papers, construction papers or color printing papers, a scissor, 36+ color markers, a black sharpie(fine tip), 5 pebbles, craft paints or acrylic paints (12 colors +) , a set of brushes, a Hot glue gun and glue sticks.

Topics

Jun.7 Pebble painting: a family of birds

Students will learn how to paint a scenery background on a piece a wood block/ a canvas panel. They also will paint 5 pebbles in different colors.

Jun.14 Pebble painting: a family of birds

Students will paint details of the birds and arrange a wood branch to creative a 3D art work.

Jun.21 Paper collage: colorful Chameleons

Students will learn how to sketch chameleons.

Jun.28 Paper collage: colorful Chameleons

Students will use color papers/ magazine papers to finish the artwork.

July.5 Still life drawing: two flower vase on tonal graduation

Students will learn how to sketch different type of vases. They also will work on graduate tonal background.

July.12 Perspective landscape drawing.

Students will learn how to sketch a perspective landscape.

July.19 Perspective landscape drawing.

Students will complete the artwork with colors and patterns.

July.26 Illusion art drawing: 3D Holes & Stairs

Students will learn a technique to form a 3D illusion from a 2D drawing.

Aug.2 Animal portrait painting: Panda

Students will learn how to sketch a panda with bamboo. They also will paint the background.

Aug.9 Animal portrait painting: Panda

Students will complete the painting with details.

Aug.16 Picasso portrait

Students will learn to draw the facial parts in Picasso style

Aug.23 Picasso portrait

Students will use the facial parts they create from last class and make a portrait of a family member.
